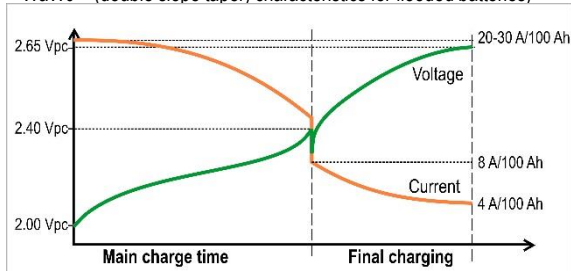

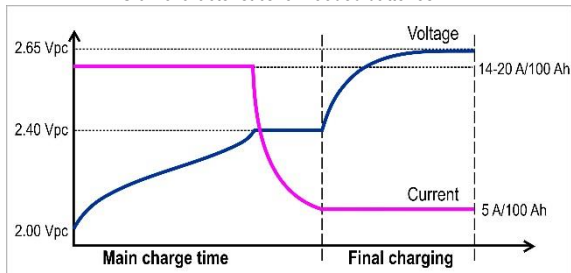

Charging profiles: WaW0 and IUla Charge factor: 1.10 – 1.20

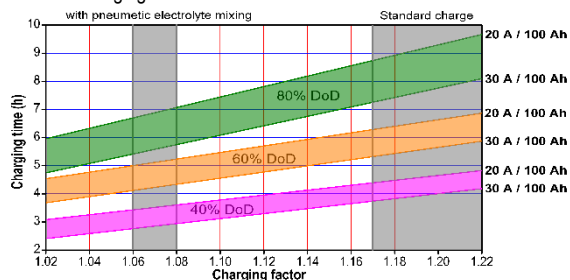
WaW0 – (double slope taper) characteristics for flooded batteries



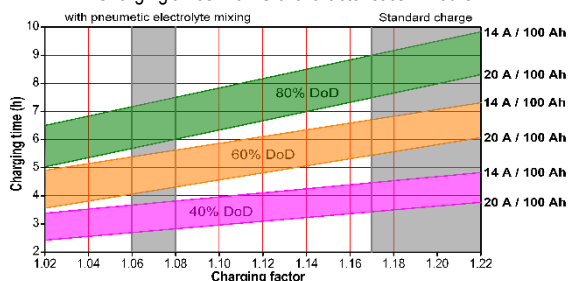
IUla – characteristics for flooded batteries
